_____ ATTENDING ALL SCHEDULED REHEARSALS

Students must attend all their rehearsals scheduled. Monthly calendars with rehearsal dates will be distributed to students. If a student is absent, it prevents others from getting the most out of rehearsal time. **Students can miss a rehearsal if it is excused by a parent due to an illness or emergency only.** Excused absences can be made for medical appointments or pre-play planned appointments or other events. More than two unexcused absences will result in your child being removed from the production.

_____ PRODUCTION COST

Students will be required to pay a Non-refundable fee of \$50 due before read-through. This fee helps to off-set the cost of the production. Base costume pieces or shoes may be requested.

_____ PRACTICING GOOD BEHAVIOR

Respecting others in this cast is detrimental to a great performance. It is very important to create a team environment for a good production. If you are: disrespecting others, defying authority, disruptive during rehearsals or vandalizing school property, you will be removed from the production.

_____ MAINTAINING GRADES

Students will be required to keep their grades up. If a student has a D or lower; or poor behavior in any class, they will be placed on Academic Probation. We will give the student two weeks to raise their grades. If they fail to do so, they will be dropped from the show.
